

# The Lake Waubeeka Boat Registration Permit Program

Boat stickers are mandatory for all water vehicles—whether used from your dock at home or on the beaches. Water vehicles include rowboats, canoes, kayaks, and paddleboats.

**Unless your water vehicle is brand new, it is imperative that all water vehicles used in any other water besides Lake Waubeeka be scrubbed with a sanitizer or bleach prior to use to stop the entrance of zebra mussels into our lake.**

All water vehicles must be stored at designated areas at the Post Street Beach and Paul Street Beach. All water vehicles must be removed from the beach at designated dates in the fall of each year.

All boats, kayaks, canoes, and paddleboats belonging to Members and their authorized renters should have a permit affixed to the front right or left side above the water line.

Do not request stickers for non-owner guests such as visiting family members, friends, etc. Renters are limited to the names on the lease filed with Lake Waubeeka Association, Inc. **No motorized boats are allowed in the lake and these will not be issued a permit.**
